Joe Esposito, longest serving NYPD chief of department, dies at 73

NEW YORK — Former NYPD Chief of Department Joe Esposito has died at 73, <u>WABC</u> reported.

Mayor Eric Adams announced Esposito's death via a post on X, in which he described Esposito as "the definition of public service."

"He served his city on our darkest days and brightest moments," he shared. "In recent years, Joe continued his service as deputy commissioner of the Department of Buildings while battling cancer."

Esposito served as an NYPD officer and rose through the ranks to become the longestserving chief of department in the NYPD's history, according to the report.

Fax: 212.233.0548, <u>depression</u>, <u>anxiety</u>, marital and relationship conflict, <u>substance use</u>, and suicide. Utilizing NYPD officers who volunteer with POPPA and a professional mental health network, POPPA reduces the gap between essential support services and officers' access to these services.

Retiree Program

In 2006, POPPA started its Retiree Program. The program began with 26 retired NYPD officers dedicated to help meet the needs of fellow retired police officers. The mental health and other unique needs of this group are often overlooked. Retired police officers can use POPPA services for a variety of stress or mental health issues, relationship problems, substance use, or if they feel suicidal. Sometimes, retirees just need to reconnect with another person who can identify as a law enforcement peer.

The Retiree Program has grown to more than 100 volunteers spanning several states across the country in addition to New York.

After his tenure as chief of department, Esposito served as commissioner of New York City Emergency Management from 2014 to 2019 and as the deputy commissioner of the Department of Buildings.

Esposito will be remembered for his role in leading the NYPD through times of difficulty, like the aftermath of the 9/11 terror attacks and Super Storm Sandy, according to the report.

"He worked hard for his city, right up to the end. And he left it a better place," Mayor Adams stated.




