The Palm Beach County Veterans Court
In 2009, Jerry Klein, Roy Foster and the late Dave
Knapp attended a meeting, presided by Judge
Robert Russell, who developed the first Veterans
Court in Buffalo N.Y. The trio so inspired by the
Judges speech, obtained all the information
regarding the formation, training and operating of
the Buffalo Court.

Florida has one of the largest veteran populations in the United States, and with that many came home with emotional problems, PTSD, Alcohol, Drugs, aggression and so forth. These ailments can be addressed with the correct treatment as Judge Russell explained.

Klein, Foster and Knapp shook the trees and beat the bushes and in November 2010 the PBC Veterans Court began. The lineup was Judge Ted Booras, a Marine, States Atty. Robert Jaegers, Lt. Col. USAF, Defense Atty., Steve Benedict, US Army, and Louis Kurtz, Probation Officer, Army, and a group of veterans trained as mentors. Additionally, there is the Veterans Administration Hospital who provides Calvin Sloan who tracks all the veterans to insure they keep of their treatment appointments. The VA Hospital provides all the treatment for the veterans, without their cooperation this program would not work

Many of the Veteran Courts, through the country, would only handle misdemeanors, but Judge Booras insisted on handling felonies as well misdemeanors, or crimes as well as Traffic citations or for those who have had their licenses suspended. The court does not accept homicide related offences, kidnapping, sexual predators, career criminals or those wanting to pled innocent, those cases must stay in the regular system. DUI'S because of the State traffic law must be settled in the regular court but we will handle the probation

treatment. The State Atty. may object to any veteran being included in the program or if a complainant is involved, they may object to the inclusion as well.

Each veteran whose case comes to the Veterans Court, if qualified, must be evaluated at the VA Hospital for future treatment. When the veteran returns to court he is offered several options depending on the charges filed against him. Veterans Treatment Initiative, VTI, may involve from one year to a five-year involvement with the court. The veteran will plead guilty, which is held in abeyance and upon successful completion may be dismissed, meaning no conviction on the veteran's record. If there is restitution, to be made it must be paid. The court handles probation, watch and wait and other dispositions.

Each veteran in the program is assigned a mentor, another veteran to support the subject veteran through the program. Mentors are trained to develop trust in his relationship with the veteran. The mentors are not counselors, the VA does that, we do not discuss law, he has council assigned by the court. The mentors support the veterans thru their time with the court, the veteran must keep in contact with the mentor. Veterans talk to veterans as police to police and teachers talk to teachers, there is that common bond.

The system works. This November 2022, is twelve years since the beginning and we have handled over 600 cases with a 6% recidivist rate as opposed to 66% in the regulator court system
