#### Remember All of Our Fallen Heroes



#### **Robert Trotta**

I came on the job in October 68 after serving 3 years in the Army. After graduating from the Academy I was assigned to the 19 Pct. After two years on patrol I was assigned to the first Anti Crime team in the 19th. In 1972 I was transferred to the 1st Pct. Two interesting items came from this transfer: The "old 1st Pct" located on Old Slip was closed and the "new 1st Pct" was merged with the 4th Pct on Ericson Place. As most of the cops from the two merged precincts were transferred elsewhere there was a need for an Anti Crime Unit. So to make a long story short I went from the 19th Anti Crime to the 1st Anti Crime. The second interesting or historical fact is that the newly merged 1st Pct was the first precinct commanded by a female, Captain Victoria Renzullo.

During the lay-offs (75-76) I was assigned to the 1st Pct Scooter Task Force. I was transferred to OCCB in 1976 and spent the next 3 years in Queens Public Morals (QPMD) and 5 years in Manhattan South Narcotics.. In 1982 I was promoted to Detective and transferred to Mid-Town South PDU as the Squad was called back then.

In 1982, after the department authorized cops to work off duty in security related jobs, I started T & M Security Service along with John Molloy who was retired from the job.

Initially T & M was doing building and personal security for the ILGWU and was among the first company to legitimately employ off duty and retired members of the service. In 1983, while still working in MTS, T & M was awarded a contract by the IBM Corporation to provide security at 11 of their office locations in NYC and Westchester County. At the same time John Molloy became seriously ill and could no longer remain in the company. As a result I made the decision to vest my pension (16 years) and retire. T & M continued to grow and by 1992 over 200 off duty and retired cops were employed by T & M. After the 1993 attack on the World Trade Center T & M was hired by the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) to provide support security to its proprietary security and personal protection to the executives; their homes and families. It was during this time that T & M started an Explosive Detection Canine Division (EDC) . T & M also provided personal security to several celebrities. Most notably were the rock stars Frank Zappa and George Harrison.

I personally provided those services and traveled with the former Beatle when he toured Japan with Eric Clapton. I worked for Harrison when he was in NY up until his death in 2001.

In 2000 I sold a majority share of the company to Robert Tucker, Chief of Staff to Queens DA Judge Richard Brown. I stayed with T & M until 2011, when I retired and moved to Jupiter Florida. T & M continued to grow and is still a major player in the security industry.

In 2017 I was diagnosed with a rare form of T Cell Lymphoma, that Illness, along with the prostate cancer I had in 2015 were deemed to by caused by toxin from the WTC.

In 2018 after 9 cycles of chemo I received a successful bone marrow transplant.

It was during this time that I wrote my first novel, Murder in the Gardens. My second novel Murder at the Florida Classic was published in 2019. Both novels are fiction but some of the characters are based on the people I worked with in the PD, I am currently working on the 3rd novel with the same protagonist.

Both books are available on Amazon.in both paper- back and Kindle.

I believe I am an original member of our Lodge, if not I joined shortly after it was sanctioned by the National FOP.
